DETAILED PROBE UNDERWAY, TO IDENTIFY ROOT CAUSES: BUREAU

Too early for conclusions, says AAIB, urges restraint

IN THE WAKE of mounting international speculation over the cause of the Air India flight 171 crash, the Aircraft Accident Investigation Bureau (AAIB) on Thursday issued a statement, urging media and the public to refrain from drawing premature conclusions while the investigation remains ongoing.

The appeal came hours after *The Wall Street Journal* reported that the cockpit voice recorder of the plane suggests that the first officer questioned the captain about switching off the aircraft's fuel supply just seconds before the crash. Citing unnamed sources, the report identified the voices captured in the recording and highlighted the confusion in the cockpit, reviving speculation around possible human error.

The June 12 crash killed 260 people shortly after the flight took off from Ahmedabad for London Gatwick. AAIB, which released a preliminary report last week, has now reiterated that it is too early to pinpoint the cause.

"It has come to our attention that certain sections of the international media are repeatedly attempting to

draw conclusions through selective and unverified reporting," GVG Yugandhar, AAIB director-general, said. "Such actions are irresponsible, especially while the investigation remains ongoing."

Without naming the *WSJ* report directly, the AAIB warned that efforts to assign blame at this stage risk compromising the integrity of the probe. "This is not the time to create public anxiety or angst towards the safety of the Indian aviation industry, particularly on the basis of unfounded facts," Yugandhar said.

The bureau stressed that the preliminary report is only

meant to outline "what" happened, and not "why". The detailed examination of flight data and cockpit recordings, along with technical assessments, are still underway. "At this stage, it is too early to reach any definite conclusions. The final investigation report will come out with root causes and recommendations," AAIB said.

The bureau also underscored its track record of professional, independent investigations, noting it has handled 92 accidents and 111 serious incidents since its inception in 2012. The probe into the AI 171 crash is being conducted in line with the Air-

craft (Investigation of Accidents and Incidents) Rules, 2017, and the standards laid out in ICAO Annex 13.

Investigators are exploring both human and mechanical possibilities behind the inadvertent shutdown of the aircraft's engines.

Acknowledging the intense public interest and the grief of the victims' families, AAIB said it would release updates when appropriate. "It is essential to respect the sensitivity of the loss faced by family members of deceased passengers, crew of the aircraft and other deceased persons on ground," the bureau said.

There's no evidence to suggest pilot downed plane: US expert

US AVIATION EXPERT Mary Schiavo has rejected claims that human error led to the Air India crash in Ahmedabad, which left 260 people dead.

A report by *WSJ* has claimed that the cockpit voice recordings (CVRs) suggest that Captain Sumeet Sabharwal cut off the fuel supply.

"There is no evidence of this," Schiavo told *financial-express.com*. "There was an ANA (All Nippon Airways) flight in 2019 in which the 787 aircraft did this itself, while the flight was on final approach. No pilot input cutting off the fuel whatsoever," she said.

The software glitch had made the Boeing 787 think that it was on the ground, and that is why the thrust control malfunction accommodation system cut the fuel supply to the engines, the veteran US aviation attorney said. "The pilots never

touched the fuel cutoff," Schiavo added. "The voices, words and sounds on CVRs must be carefully analysed. There is nothing here to suggest pilot suicide or murder. The full transcript of the CVR should be released ASAP to avoid harmful paraphrasing," she said.

Pilots' body flags concerns over AAIB's preliminary report

The Federation of Indian Pilots (FIP) on Thursday asked the government to reassess possible technical misinterpretation or mechanical faults in the Boeing 787-8 plane and sought inclusion of subject matter experts in the probe.

Flagging concerns about the AAIB report, FIP said it failed to sufficiently consider or acknowledge two plausible and previously documented technical scenarios, either of which could have triggered an automated shutdown of both engines. FIP has written a letter to the civil aviation ministry, raising various concerns related to the crash probe and the preliminary report, according to a source.

In the letter, the association alleged that it is not the first time that systemic failures within Boeing aircraft have initially been attributed to pilot error or suicidal intent, only to be disproven by subsequent investigations.

Beauty tips from Mexico

L'OREAL WOULD BE HOPING THAT THE NEW INDIA HEAD IS ABLE TO REPLICATE THE SUCCESS THAT THE MEXICAN OPERATIONS ACHIEVED UNDER HIS STEWARDSHIP

L'OREAL CEO NICOLAS Hieronimus laid it out on the table in June when he told Indian reporters in Paris that he saw the country as a land of opportunities. "It is one of the fastest-growing beauty markets in the world and is a big priority for L'Oreal," he said.

Contributing just over 1% to L'Oreal's global turnover of \$47 billion (₹4 lakh crore), the topline of the Indian operations of the company (at ₹5,685 crore in FY25) hardly reflects the ambitions of its CEO. The French major wants to dial up growth and more than double the business in India over the next few years. The appointment of Jacques Lebel this week as the country manager for India (effective October 1) must be viewed through this lens, industry executives said. He succeeds company veteran and current country head Aseem Kaushik, who will transition to the role of chairman.

The LSE and Harvard Business School alumnus, Lebel, who was previously general manager of the consumer products division for L'Oreal in Mexico, will be expected to hit the ground running. The Indian unit, which manufactures and markets L'Oreal Paris apart from others

such as Garnier, Maybelline New York and NYX Professional Makeup, produces about half a billion units in the country. It also exports to markets such as West Asia.

Lebel has been described as one with a "sharp and aggressive mind", who will bring his multiple-market and cross-category experience to India. The consumer goods veteran, who has previously worked with Procter & Gamble (P&G) and AB InBev, has nearly two decades behind him. He has worked in Europe, US, Africa, West Asia and Latin America and is said to have a deep understanding of brands across

beauty and personal, alcohol and beverages. India is not alien to Lebel as he was a marketing and innovation leader for P&G's oral care business 10 years ago, spearheading expansion of the Oral-B brand in India, West Asia and Africa.

L'Oreal Mexico has consistently shown strong growth in the consumer products division, notably in haircare, skincare and makeup, industry sources said, thanks to Lebel's execution abilities and strategic thinking. The consumer products division drives mainly mass-market brands (such as L'Oreal Paris), and Mexico, like India, is one of the two priority markets for the beauty major alongside Brazil in Latin America.


Recent years have seen L'Oreal India face increasing competition from not just legacy players such as Hindustan Unilever and Godrej Consumer, but also direct-to-consumer brands and retailers such as Nykaa and Reliance's Tira as well as a steady stream of international labels that have made a beeline here. A Redseer-Nykaa report values India's beauty market at \$20 billion, which is slated to touch \$34 billion

by 2028 as consumers seek better products, backed by higher disposable incomes and greater awareness of beauty trends thanks to the explosion of social media channels (such as Instagram) and influencers.

Beauty is uniquely positioned, an industry executive said, because it touches people across age groups and incomes. "A housewife in a small town is as interested in the most trending beauty topic as is a Gen Z consumer or millennial. This is both an opportunity and challenge because while you may have a large addressable market, the challenge is to be relevant to each one of them in terms of price, packaging, positioning and trade channel," he said.

The French major is believed to be counting on Lebel to drive growth at the Indian unit, much like he did in Mexico. Both India and Mexico are currently ranked among L'Oreal's top 15 markets globally. The growth rate of the India business of L'Oreal, however, has been around 14-15% per annum in terms of topline in recent years, lower than the around 30% growth rate per annum it was seeing earlier.

Industry executives say that the L'Oreal global management hopes to see India get into the list of top 10 markets in the future, tapping a growing base of consumers across the country, using a combination of affordable and premium products. The company reaches around 250 million consumers with its products across the country. Lebel will look to push this number up as he targets greater reach for the beauty major's brands in India.
